Who? What?

Incorporated in the customs of many tribal civilizations is a period of meditation and introspection given to individuals on the brink of maturity. The value of this opportunity for self-discovery, as we might now term it, can hardly be overestimated, yet it is significantly absent in our turbulent times.

Or, almost.

Though we may no longer be sent out into a wilderness, solitary and empty-handed, with nothing but our inner resources to discover and draw upon, there exists in our society an institution, namely the single sex college, where a young woman may have an experience of an allied nature in that it, too, places the individual in a situation where she is, to a certain extent, removed from any role into which she may have been brought up. In this specialized form of academic life, it is possible to stand unhampered by the myriad subtle man-woman relationships, and family relationships (though this would also be the case in a co-ed college) which she will necessarily have formed, but which leave many people with the age-old question, who am I, what do I want? The student, released from these roles and in an atmosphere of intellectual and social freedom, can discover the true nature and extent of her inner resources. Upon returning wholly to a "normal" society, this experience will have provided a far more solid basis for her life than she might otherwise have acquired.

It is particularly in relation to the evolution of sexual equality that the possible psychological advantages of the women's college should be examined. It is not just a question of finding a career and getting equal pay for it. It is rather a matter of piercing to the marrow, and not saying ten years hence, like Prufrock, "That is not what I meant at all. That is not it at all."

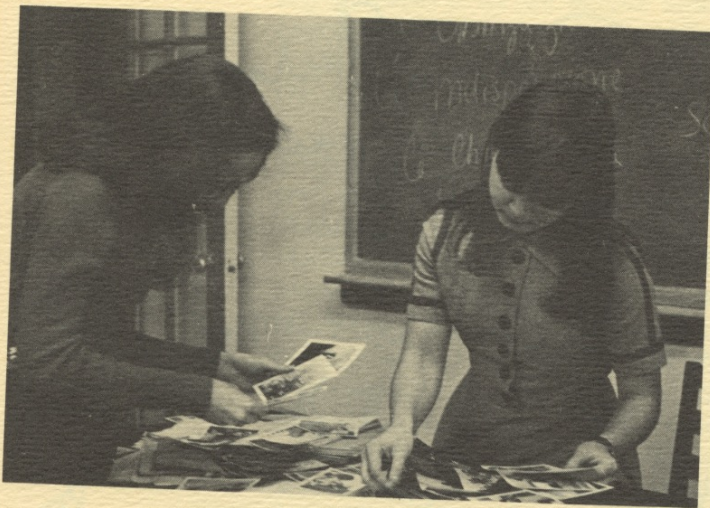
